EARLY CHILDHOOD UNIFIED Program

The Early Childhood Unified (ECU) program at Newman University provides you with the educational background necessary to implement developmentally appropriate practices in a high quality, inclusive early childhood setting birth to grade 3.

What if you already have an elementary education degree with initial licensure?

If you already have an elementary education degree, you can add your Early Childhood Unified endorsement to your teaching credentials **IN JUST ONE SEMESTER!**

- All courses are offered in the summer to allow for students to be immersed in early childhood content.
- Wichita campus courses are held via face-to face and online instruction.
- Western and Southeast Kansas campus courses are held via ITV utilizing experienced local ECU educators.
- We now offer an accelerated program for Elementary Education at all three campuses. ECU can easily be completed the semester prior to beginning the elementary education program.

For degree-seeking students, the undergraduate ECU program at Newman University includes 58 credits from the elementary education program. An additional 16 hours focused on ECU coursework and field experiences in diverse settings is required.

As this is a dual licensure program, upon completion of all courses and assessments, graduates are eligible for both the elementary education license (K-6th grade) and the early childhood unified license (birth-grade 3), which qualifies individuals for both general education and special education teaching positions.
